ART SCHOLARSHIP INCLUDES MUSIC (INSTRUMENTAL/VOICE), DRAMA, TECH CREW 'SLAB' AND DANCE

Scholarship applicants will be assessed on the following criteria:

1. Submission of:
 - An Application for Enrolment [online](#) (new students only), and
 - An Arts Scholarship Application Form by the closing date: **24 May 2024**
2. Demonstrated ability in their chosen Arts field (refer to back page for more information).
3. School reports & NAPLAN results.
4. Reference from teacher/instructor/coach in their chosen Arts field.

Scholarship recipients are expected to:

1. Maintain a commitment to their studies.
2. Be a good role model.
3. Support the activities of the Department.
4. Contribute to the total Arts program upon which their scholarship is based including:
 - Study the subject/s relevant to their field.
 - Take private lessons.
 - Rehearse, perform and commit to school ensembles, troupe and clubs (e.g. SLAB).
 - Commit to performance opportunities throughout the year including school and house musical activities, assemblies and chapels as applicable. Please note many of these events and shows occur outside of normal school hours.
 - Travel if necessary to participate in performances at other centres in Australia or overseas.

THE CONTINUATION OF A SCHOLARSHIP DEPENDS ON EXEMPLARY:

- Performance within the scholarship category
- Conduct in all aspects of schooling
- Endeavor across all subject (demonstrated by a minimum grade of B for effort)
- Service to the School community (demonstrated through participation in competitions/clubs, contribution to house etc.,)



ABILITY WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH FIELD AS FOLLOWS:

Music ability:

Instrumental/Voice:

- Year 4 scholarship applicants should have been learning their instrument for at least 12 months.
- Year 7 scholarships applicants should be approximately Grade 3 AMEB or equivalent.
- Year 10 scholarship applicants should be approximately Grade 6 AMEB or equivalent.
- Results from music exams and/or Eisteddfod performances.
- Chosen instrument(s).
- An audition demonstrating ability to perform two contrasting pieces on their main instrument/voice and one piece on their second instrument. Accompaniment is optional. Sight-reading, aural and technical work will also be given.

Drama ability:

- AMEB or Trinity qualifications for Drama.
- Results in classroom Drama.
- Participation in plays/productions/workshops.
- Links to theatre groups.
- A monologue performance at audition. One prepared monologue of the applicants choosing, and one piece to be sight read and improvised. Students are given 5 minutes to prepare their unseen monologue but are not expected to memorise the lines.

SLAB (tech crew) ability:

- Demonstrated interest /knowledge in the technical aspects of event production, including:
 - › Experience in the set-up of; sound systems, microphones, DIs and Foldback with correct cabling and cable management.
 - › Experience in mixing sound, either in a live environment or using software, such as Pro Tools, Logic Pro etc.
 - › Experience in QLAB; programming and operating with audio and/or visual cues.
 - › Experience in programming DMX and/or Lighting Design/and/or Lighting desk operation.
 - › Experience in operating a video camera under various lighting conditions, and/or experience with live-streamed footage capture using industry standard equipment'.
- Desired traits including attention to detail, organised, able to work in a team, willing to learn how to use new equipment, and taking appropriate responsibility for facets of a show.
- Experience/qualifications/ certificates or courses in related disciplines and/or commitment to attend training courses run at school.

Dance ability:

- RAD or Trinity qualifications for Dance.
- Results from dance exams and/or Eisteddfod performances.
- Chosen dance style(s).
- An audition demonstrating proficiency in two or more dance styles.
